

**OFF-LICENCE***Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012*

**Pursuant** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **ALLSOMM LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 7/87 Bridge Street, Ahuriri, Napier and known as "Cellar Ahuriri", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises, and to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

**CONDITIONS**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day:  
 (b) Alcohol may be sold or delivered on the following days and during the following hours:

**Monday to Sunday, between 9.00am to 10.00pm.**

- (c) Water must be freely available to customers, while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.  
 (d) The following steps must be taken by the licensee to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
- Appropriate signs must be prominently displayed adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- (e) The following steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:
- The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in their host responsibility policy.
- (f) The whole of the interior of the premises is designated as a supervised area.  
 (g) The licensee must ensure that for each principal entrance to the premises the licence is displayed at all times, attached to the inside or outside of the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the entrance, stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises are open for the sale of alcohol.

**DURATION**

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) Either—
- (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
- (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
